HOW TO BE SURE THAT YOU ARE SAVED

ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

Salvation is the most powerful and spiritual experience you can receive this side of Heaven. Salvation is not only the gift of God it opens you to all that God has promised for those who are in Christ (saved)

[Take a look at Titus 3:3-7](#)

"At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. 4But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, 5he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, 6whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, 7so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

God has done a great work in you life. A new beginning, new life and new future are yours now that you are saved (In Christ). This salvation is powerful and eternal. Here are two things to remember as you grow in you faith.

First God wants you to be filled with assurance of the salvation you received. He wants you to enjoy it and grow deep. Here is what the Holy Spirit says to all those who have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord.

[1 John 5:11-13](#)

"And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. 12He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

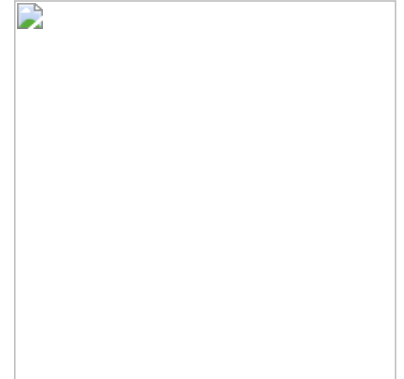
And.....seek to memorize this verse

13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life."

It is clear that God wants you to know that your saved.

Secondly He also wants you to be aware of the [enemy of salvation](#). Satan doesn't want you to be sure of your salvation or grow deep in Christ. The devil and [dark powers](#) will seek to weaken you and cause you to doubt. As a new Christian you should know that spiritual warfare means that at times your faith will be challenged. But God plans and will give you the victory and all the assurance you need.

God shows us in the Word of God the work of the tempter.



The WORD of GOD and the assurance of Salvation

So lets dig into the Word of God and see what it says about the assurance of your salvation.

Here are two primary ways and 7 other confirming Biblical spiritual evidences that assure you that you are saved. God really wants you to be totally confident of that salvation.(in Christ)

**HOW TO BE SURE THAT YOU ARE SAVED
(ASSURANCE OF SALVATION)**

1. THE WORD OF GOD SAYS YOU ARE IF YOU RECEIVED CHRIST

The Word of God is the foundation of your faith. It is the very words of God and in it He reveals the way of salvation and the assurance of being saved. The Word of God is the outward witness of your salvation. Remember [Romans 10:9-12](#)

"That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. 11As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." [a] 12For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, 13for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

2. THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD SAYS TO YOUR spirit YOU ARE SAVED

At the moment of receiving Jesus into your life you revived the promised Holy Spirit of God. The Spirit of God in you assures you inwardly that you are His (in Christ and saved) Romans chapter [8 Reveals](#) the work and witness of the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer that they are a child of God and in Christ.

"because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. [g] And by him we cry, "Abba, [h] Father." 16The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. 17Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory."

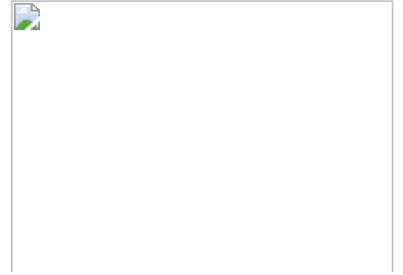

STUDY OVER PSALM 103 WHAT BENEFITS ARE REVEALED?

So many things occur at the moment of salvation that it takes some time to discover all the 'benefits' that are included with and because of salvation. We are told in Hebrews 2:3 not to" ignore such a great salvation?". Salvation changes everything. God sees you different now that you are saved. See what the Word of God says in Colossians 1:21 "Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. 22 But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—"

I want to encourage you to open your heart to God's teaching and dig into the Biblical revelation of the depths of this salvation you now have. Let each scripture imprint its truth in your life.

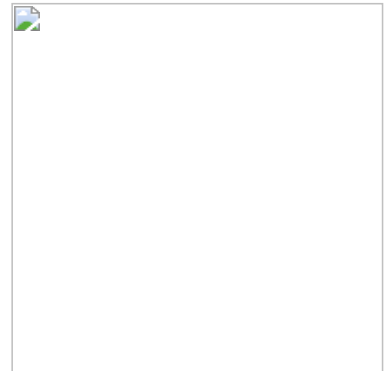

3. THIS SALVATION IS AN EXPERIENCE/EVENT AND A PROCESS WITH A GOAL

There are three main terms that describe the full scope of this great salvation.

JUSTIFICATION

[This means what as discribed in the pod cast?](#)

I am saved and right before God. I have peace and fellowship with God. God sees me as clean and as His child. I am as clean, close and accepted by God as possible.....because of the life, cross and blood of Jesus Christ.

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9not by works, so that no one can boast. 10For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

SACTIFICATION

This means what as discribed in the pod cast?

I am empowered to live for Christ, to be like him. I have been given Victory over the flesh/sin nature, the fallen world and the devil. I am called to grow and can serve God with joy. I will bear fruit and have His help all my life.

GLORIFICATION

This means what as discribed in the pod cast?

**Because of being saved and Justified I will be instantly changed at the first resurrection([rapture-catching up](#)). In an atomic flash my motal body with go from mortal to immortal and I shall have an eternal body. This is the goal of my salvation.

God exists! He is there whether a person knows Him or not. He is present everywhere at all times. God is unlimited, infinite and OMNIPRESENT. See here what scriptures says

Who would want to take the time to memorize the Word of God? Well lets see, there's Moses, Joshua, David, Daniel, Paul, Mary, Steven, Philip, Peter, many others and Jesus Himself.

As you read the new testament you will see all of the above quoting the scripture and in many different circumstances.

They quoted the Word (from memory) while praying, worshiping, evangelizing, teaching, defending and even while battling the devil himself. Scriptures are the Living Words of God, they have His life and power in them. You can't be saved or grow deep without them. So memorizing them will become a treasure of knowledge and a way to be fruitful in life and ministry.

Little knowledge of scripture means little spiritual power, faith and works. All great believers who did great things for God had scripture in their lives.....and could quote it as needed along the way.

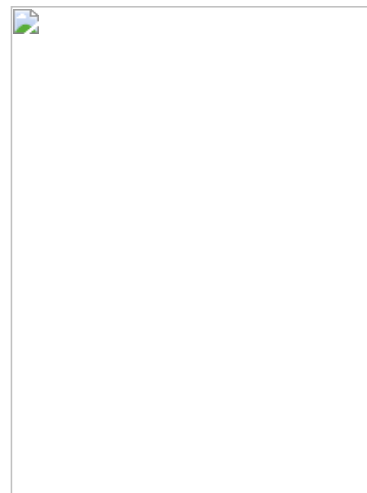

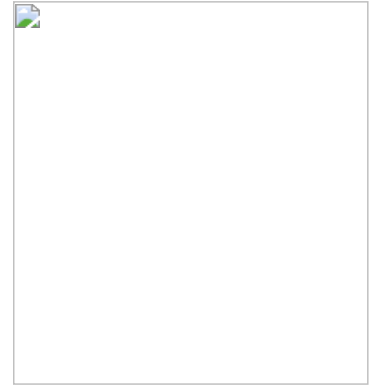

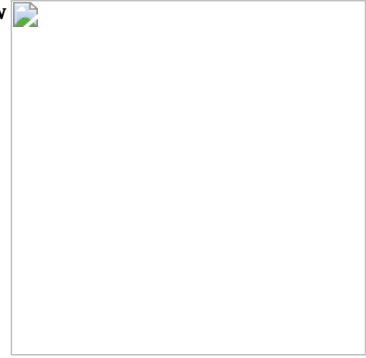

Jesus said we would be clothed with power from on high. This is a key insight and promise that He gave to us. It was and is expected to be experienced. 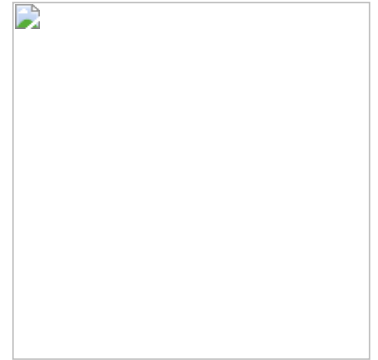
F. THE HOLY SPIRIT BEFORE AND THEN AT SALVATION

A. REPENT AND FORSAKE SIN AND DOUBT Proverbs 28:13; 1 John 1:19; 2 Cor. 7:1

B. YEILD ALL YOUR LIFE TO JESUS/BE OBEDIENCE TO HIS WORD AND MISSION Romans 12; Psalm 81:10; Matthew 28 the great commission

C. ASK FOR AND BY FAITH RECIEVE THE FULLNESS AND POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT It is God's will to be Filled Epn.5; 1John 5

TAKE THE TIME TO GET BEFORE GOD AND SEEK BY FAITH THIS GRACE AND PROMISE!

When you seek and by faith recieve the power of the Holy Spirit and are filled you may feel God's power all over you. Some have shouted and praised God others knelt to the ground in holy awe and joy...others shook some cried and many poured into worship and praise. Some had gifts of the Spirit come on them at that moment others just got up and started witnessing and winning souls to Jesus.
